





School Bus Safety Week: A Driver's Perspective

In Massachusetts, it is mandatory that drivers who wish to maintain their Commercial Oriver's Cicense take a minimum of eight safety classes per year. The classes feature lectures from other drivers about various topics on school bus safety. This year, I've heard lessons on making sure to account for children running around near the school bus during pick up and drop off, navigating wet leaves in the fail and snow and slick surface concerns for winter driving.

It was great to see so many drivers not only in attendance at the meetings, but leading the discussions as well. We vowed to keep safety at the top of our priority list as drivers when we go back to our schools to share what we've learned with our students and fellow staff members.
